AudioFAX Strikes License Deal With Cisco for AudioFAX Fax Technology

Jump to first matched term

ATLANTA, June 19 /PRNewswire/ -- **AudioFAX IP LLC** announced today that it has entered into a patent license agreement with Cisco Systems, Inc. (Nasdaq: CSCO) under **AudioFAX's** fax patents. The deal also settles patent litigation pending between the parties.

The **AudioFAX** patents cover a broad range of inventions that incorporate fax store-and-forward technologies. Many of these are used daily by millions and include products and services such as fax mail, fax broadcasting, and "real-time" fax over the Internet.

"Cisco is a market leader of fax and unified messaging products," stated Mark Bloomfield, managing director of Atlanta-based **AudioFAX**. "We are pleased to have reached an agreement with Cisco."

AudioFAX IP LLC was established to license and administrate its telecommunications patents. The company was created as a spin-off from **AudioFAX, Inc.**, an Atlanta-based company founded in 1987, which is credited with pioneering many of the technologies now used in the enhanced fax industry. **AudioFAX** initiated a patent licensing program in early 1997 with the help of intellectual property consulting firm InteCap and the law firms of Powell, Goldstein, Frazer & Murphy LLP (**AudioFAX** licensing and litigation counsel) and Womble, Carlyle, Sandridge & Rice (**AudioFAX's** patent counsel).

"The **AudioFAX** Licensing Program has never been stronger or more active," said William M. Ragland, Jr., **AudioFAX's** chief counsel and Co-Chair of Powell Goldstein's Technology & Intellectual Property Group. "**AudioFAX's** team at InteCap is doing a great job in offering the industry access to this important technology."

Since its inception, the **AudioFAX** Patent Licensing Program has entered into license agreements with over 20 companies, some of which include AT&T, MCI Telecommunications, Sprint, Cable & Wireless, 3Com, Mitel, Captaris (formerly known as AVT), FaxNet Corp. (now part of Critical Path), Orntool, Premiere Technologies (PTEK Holdings), Boston Technology (now part of Comverse Technology), Delrina Corporation (part of Symantec), Digital Sound Corporation (now known as PulsePoint Communications and part of Unisys), FaxSav (formerly known as NetMoves and now part of EasyLink Services), Bazillion, UNIFI Communications, VoiceCom Systems (part of PTEK Holdings), and Xpedite (part of PTEK Holdings).

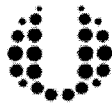
